BIOGRAPHY

MARK PANCRAZIO, B.A., J.D., is an attorney with a main office in New Fairfield, Connecticut and a home office in Woodbury, Connecticut who, along with his partner Richard Smith, practices law in all Connecticut Courts, including the Federal Courts.
